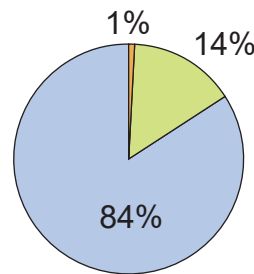
## Fulfilling Our Mission
