## Training Requirements for the Board of Directors 11/11/08

## **Training Requirements:**

MN Depart of Economic Employment and Development (DEED), Rehabilitation Services Branch (RSB, From 1998 Revised Rule):

- 1. 8 hours per year/ over a 3 year period (with 3 year cycle starting at time of last CARF accreditation)
- 2. Training hours must include
  - a. Legal mandates affecting programs, such as Rehab Act of 1973, ADA, and Extended Employment Program Statutes and Rule
  - b. Practices to improve outcome and increase the availability of extended employment services to persons with the most severe disabilities
  - c. Understanding programmatic and ethical responsibilities of nonprofit organizations to the communities they serve
  - d. Fiduciary Responsibilities of directors of nonprofit agencies (all new directors must have this training within the first 12 months of service on the Board)
- 3. A minimum of 2/3 of Board and Management must complete training (For us, this means 11 people, i.e. 3 Administrative Team members and 8 Board members).

DEED/RSB mandates that WACOSA be CARF accredited in order to be eligible to receive funding. CARF is a national accreditation organization whose acronym originally stood for the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities. It now is just referred to as the Rehabilitation Accreditation Commission. Additional requirements include:

- 1. All new members of the Board of Directors must receive orientation to the agency (does not specify what topics must be covered.)
- 2. Agencies must adhere to training requirements from both legal and other sources (For WACOSA, this means that our Board must adhere to the training requirements from RSB.)

**Day Training and Habilitation Program Rule**: No mandated training for the Board has been identified in this Rule.
