**Resolution –
Reaffirm WACOSA Title VI Policy**

Whereas, WACOSA operates its programs without regard to race, color, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, age or disability in accordance with applicable law, and

Whereas, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended provides:

"No person shall on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, sex, age, and handicap/disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance." The Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 amended Title VI to specify that entire institutions receiving Federal funds – whether schools, and colleges, government entities, or private employers – must comply with Federal civil rights laws, rather than just the particular programs or activities that receive the funds.

Whereas, the WACOSA Board of Directors has reviewed the existing WACOSA Title VI policy confirming that WACOSA is committed to complying with the requirements of Title VI in all of its programs including federally funded programs and activities.

Resolved that the Board of Directors of WACOSA affirms the existing WACOSA Title VI policy.
