 - i. 900 letters are being prepared right now. Will send out a bit earlier this year as they say there will be many letters going out on a broader non-local scale with recession
- Give to the Max Update
 - i. Got the \$4000 matching funds from Board members Goal is \$15,000
- Friends and Family mailing
 - i. Sent out a mailing of approximately 500 to friends and family of clients that have never given before only got 3 donations. Discussion that although I was disappointed upon reflection, am realizing that this was just a touch point.
