1. Welcome

2. Planned Giving:

- Ed Update
 - i. We have 12 members that are still alive and have estate gifts. In 2022, the amount of money that was received was \$142,000. Total number of gifts in 2022 was 13. Since the endowments started, we have received 24 gifts. We added \$85,000 to the endowment back in January of 2023.
 - ii. Ed wanted to call attention to a few items. The first year the money was spent on Donor Research, Staff Training, Helping WACOSA put policies in place. Second year was spent on Donor research and cultivation.
 - iii. QCD: Another highlight QCD's. This is a way for a donor over the age of 73 to make a donation from their required minimum distribution. There was a 67% increase in donors for those who use QCD's.
 - iv. On February 27th, there will be a Board Training Session on QCD's. Ed is going to be winding down his time about mid-year. They are transitioning now. Pat flicker and Nancy Bett's will be partnering to maintain and grow donors numbers.
- KPI for Planned Giving Program
 - i. Pat presented updated numbers and explained the different information for new/new members.
